2	To consider and respond to the final draft of the Community Led Plan:	
	Cllr Fitzpatrick gave a brief update on the history of the plan and the progress so far. A steering group, consisting of 6/7 members, had been formed to look at the plan- chaired by Simon Baldry.	
	Cllr Wilkins raised concerns over proposed timescales and that Brickhill PC are named against all but one of the actions in the delivered by column.	
	Cllr Rider contested action 13 - NHS to continue to survey residents on the demand for medical provision. This in fact has not been agreed and may lead to raised expectations.	
	Other comments received were: • Too many action points • Concentrate on the high priority • Steering group to continue to lead with BPC Cllr involved in meetings also • Regular updates are needed at BPC meetings in the future • Cllr Fitzpatrick stated that there has been no commitment of any staff or councillors time for this	
	Cllr Blakeman raised concerns over the <u>delivered by</u> sections, who will be leading on each point (there are many organisations listed under each one)	
	Cllr Darbon commented on the layout of the document and would like a column added detailing who will be leading on each action, Cllr Fitzpatrick reported that Brickhill PC have no powers to change the document.	
	Cllr Waterhouse suggested changing some of the wording in the summary and full document, particularly amending <u>delivered by</u> to <u>stakeholders</u> instead.
