Planning Application no 10/02294/FUL It was resolved: that the committee had no objections to this application.</p> <li data-bbox="252 1267 1414 1413"> <p>2. Planning Application non 10/02129/FUL 191 Kimbolton Road. It was noted that the existing plans and the proposed plans appeared identical and this would be brought to the attention of the Planning Dept. Planning Application 10/02312/FUL 149 Brickhill Drive It was resolved that: the Parish Council objected to the proposed erection of a detached dwelling with integral garage and landscaping on this site. Planning Application 10/02401/COU 115 Brickhill Drive The committee noted an email from a resident which had been received by the clerk and which expressed objections to the proposed fish and chip shop. The</p>

committee discussed the balance of interests between the near neighbours of 115 Brickhill Drive and the whole community of Brickhill.

It was resolved: to advise the Planning Department of Bedford Borough Council that the committee found it difficult to assess the likely impact of noise and smells for the near neighbours to 115 Brickhill Drive on the basis of the ventilation and extraction arrangement details submitted with the plans. If the Borough Planning Officers were satisfied that residents concerns about noise and smells can be overcome the Parish Council would have objections to the proposed development.

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
