- **11/01089/FUL 244 Kimbolton Road** – replacement dwelling.

In the view of the Parish Council the dwelling has significantly increased in size from original plan, is obtrusive and out of character. The Council also identified an incorrect statement on change of use on the application form and also statement 3.1 of the Sustainability Report.

**Resolved:** to make no objections to this application.
- **11/01137/FUL179A Kimbolton Road** – Two storey front extension, loft conversion & single storey rear extension.

- **11/01167/FUL Putnoe Medical Centre 71A Brickhill Drive** –Front extension and alterations as part of conversion scheme to form one dwelling.  
**Resolved:** to make no objections to this application
